
FAMILY OWNED

WYCT/Cat Country 98.7 is family owned, managed and fully staffed locally in Pensacola, Florida. Cat Country 98.7 was awarded the NAB Crystal Award in 2013 and 2017 recognizing our consistent community service. Employees freely volunteer at numerous non-profits and civic organizations. Between our air staff, we have 15 rescue animals. The morning show alone has seven!

The first line of WYCT's Mission Statement is to super-serve the community and Cat Country 98.7 takes pride in being Pensacola's community leader. In November, Junior Achievement named WYCT Small Business of the Year and after existing for only 13 years, we are the only radio company in the Pensacola Chamber of Commerce Hall of Fame.

MIRACLE ON PALAFOX







The number one request we get at Christmas time, is to help with toys. What if we could raise thousands of dollars and fill more toy wishes for our Christmas Wishes program? Josh Turner, Thompson Square and Runaway June donated their time to Miracle on Palafox and tickets were sold for an affordable \$9.87. The show sold out in 12 minutes. Cat Country 98.7 took the idea from inception, to booking, to sound and served as the primary host for the event. Over \$17,000 was raised to make sure 230 families had something under the tree this year.







CHRISTMAS WISHES

Christmas Wishes is a program where listeners are asked to submit their wish online and in turn, Cat Country 98.7 tries to match as many wishes as they can with local businesses that assist in granting their request. While the idea of Christmas Wishes is to help those less fortunate, it has blossomed into a grassroots, pay it forward, campaign with several that have received assistance in the past, chiming in and granting the wishes of others. In 2016, WYCT was able to grant the Christmas Wishes for over 200 families and individuals in Escambia and Santa Rosa counties and was recently awarded the NAB Service to America Award for it's efforts.

Two examples of the 2016 Christmas Wish program include a Christmas Party with gifts for every resident at a nursing home as well as facilitating an adoption for a deserving family.



COMMUNITIES CARING

AT CHRISTMAS

This is separate from our "Christmas Wishes" program. Cat Country 98.7 works with WEAR (our local ABC affiliate) every holiday season to make sure that Foster Children on the Gulf Coast have at least one gift under the tree. All of the donations are given locally and they stay local. Our radio station is a drop off site and the Cat leads the caravan of trucks, full of toys and gifts, from various storage facilities to the fairgrounds where non - profit organizations then gather to hand out gifts to local foster families in need.









PLANT EXPLOSION

An explosion rocked the International Paper Plant in Cantonment the night on Sunday night, January 22nd.

Residents as far away as 30 miles away heard the loud Boom. Closer to the plant, residents' homes were covered in soot and eyewitnesses were describing a black, slippery substance covering Highway 29, in front of the plant. Cars were covered in this "black liquor" and the road was impassable.

Escambia Emergency Operations reported that calls began coming in at about 7:38 p.m. Station personalities, Brent Lane and Candy Cullerton were both on the air and on the scene by 8:10p.m., beating every other media to the scene. Candy spoke with eyewitnesses – local residents that heard the explosion.

Brent Lane immediately began relaying information to concerned listeners. All residents and employees were accounted for, with no reports of fatalities or injuries. Cat Country 98.7 continued to pass along information in the following weeks as a toxic black tar had covered much of the area surrounding the plant.









FILL THE MAYFLOWER

November 21st and 22nd, Cat Country 98.7 and MANNA Food Pantries teamed up with the local Mayflower moving company (Coastal Moving and Storage) for the 8th year to collect food to help our local food pantry through the holiday season. Every air personality and staff member assisted and broadcasted live during the 2 day event and was able to collect over 80,000 pounds of food.

The Making Strides Against Breast Cancer walk is the largest fundraising event for Breast Cancer research in Escambia and Santa Rosa counties and the biggest walk (per capita) in the state of Florida. Cat Country has been a sponsor for 10 years. "Team Cat A Tude" is made of hundreds of listeners are invited to join and walk with the team. This year, the cause hit especially close to home, as Morning Man, Brent Lane's wife who chairs our team every year was struck with breast cancer. Every employee walked in this fight against breast cancer. On Saturday, October 29th, 2016, WYCT helped raise more than \$400,000 with more than 15,000 participants.

Local News: Since its inception in 2003, Cat Country 98.7/ WYCT has showcased local news with traffic and weather. Our inhouse news team has won several dozen accolades during the last decade, including two Edward R. Murrow Awards for the BP Oil Spill and the Blue Angel Crash in 2016.

Local Traffic: Pensacola alone is home to over 100 bridges. If there is an accident on one, commutes can come to a standstill. Our traffic reports are live with inhouse traffic reporters six times an house from 5a-9a, 4p-6p and throughout the day/night as needed. WYCT works in conjunction with the Florida Department of Transportation, the Sherriff's office, the City Police and listeners that become everyone's eyes and ears if they see an accident in NW Florida.

Local Weather: Since Cat Country 98.7/WYCT is live and local every day, we relay severe weather and emergency information as needed. We have live reporters at the Emergency Operations Center in Escambia and Santa Rosa Counties. We monitor "Cat Scan Radar" and are able to give updates on storms and severe weather at street level accuracy.



LIVE AND LOCAL

When Country Music Artists come to town, they can always be heard on Cat Country 98.7. During the CMA submission period, we've spoken with Florida Georgia Line, Thompson Square, Jake Owen, Midland and Kenny Chesney, just to name a few. Cat Country 98.7 is the only radio station on the Gulf Coast to do a series of free shows bringing Country Music's up and coming stars close to you. We called these free, all-ages shows "Cat Country Close Ups". Thousands of people were able to see, enjoy and meet Michael Ray, Chris Janson and Brett Young among others. Each artist did an hour-long acoustic set and they stuck around to sign autographs afterwards. We have even perfected getting 250 meet and greet pics in 45 minutes!





Country Music News: From country music news online at catcountry987.com, to country music charts, to WYCT's Music Advisory Council, our station engages listeners with the latest in country music delivering all the news from Nashville during "Cat Tales". With over 105,000 Facebook fans, country fans along the Gulf Coast usually find out the latest on their favorite artists before anyone else via Cat Country 98.7. From the air, to the streets and from the concert venue to the beach, country music is the foundation of what we are at Cat Country 98.7.

CAT COUNTRY CLOSE UPS

During our submission period, Cat Country 98.7 hosted a series of Cat Country Close Ups, "where Nashville's rising stars come to you" brought new music to over **10,000 listeners** who had the chance to see, hear and meet (for free) such talent as **Chris Lane**, **Brett Young**, **Craig Campbell**, **Chris Janson**, **Granger Smith and Midland**.


