This team came to be out of necessity. In 2010, in Dothan, Alabama, Broadway was the Program Director of a country station in need of an afternoon guy. He placed a help wanted ad and received over 400 demos. Out of those 400 hopefuls, only a few were chosen to move to the final round. Bud Ford was one of them. Bud had just started his studies at Mississippi State with a goal of becoming a television meteorologist, and leaving the radio business behind. He needed to be in a small market that would allow him to work on television, and his plan was to work on a radio station just to survive until he got his degree.





Those plans, as plans often do, were completely derailed the first time Bud and Broadway went to lunch together. There was an instant bond between the two, because Broadway has a special needs son, and Bud's little brother was special needs as well. That common thread was the catalyst for what would, in very short order, become the Bud and Broadway morning show.

Less than two months after bringing Bud on board, Broadway realized that his recently formed morning show wasn't going to work out. Sometimes, the chemistry's just not there. He approached Bud about joining him on the show, and a meeting was held between the two that would change everything.

Two years later, after becoming the number one and most talked about morning show in Southeast Alabama, Bud and Broadway made the decision to set out in search of their dream job. They were hired in Tulsa, and in less than a year, they had taken the town by storm. During their time in Tulsa, Bud and Broadway made their mark not just by being funny, but by opening up the book of their lives to the listeners.

Through good times and bad, their lives played out on the radio. In the three years they were in Tulsa, Bud's heart was broken, first by a woman, and then by the tragic death of his brother, William. On the heels of that, Broadway's mother was diagnosed with Stage 4 colon cancer and passed away six months later. They made it through these times by sharing them with their listeners, who were kind enough to make them a part of their families.

Once again their plans, as plans often do, would change over a contract issue with their company, and they found themselves parked on the sidelines. Bud and Broadway believe that God has a plan for everyone, and they were certain that the plan wasn't meant to end in Tulsa. Several months later, the opportunity presented itself to become the new morning team here at New Country 92.3, and they knew they had found their new home.

Bud and Broadway again championed the campaign supported with Facebook posts, website listings, station eblasts, and over 200 promos.




Severe Weather






JingleFest Ticket Blasts
