Chris Carr has been in country radio for over 20 years!



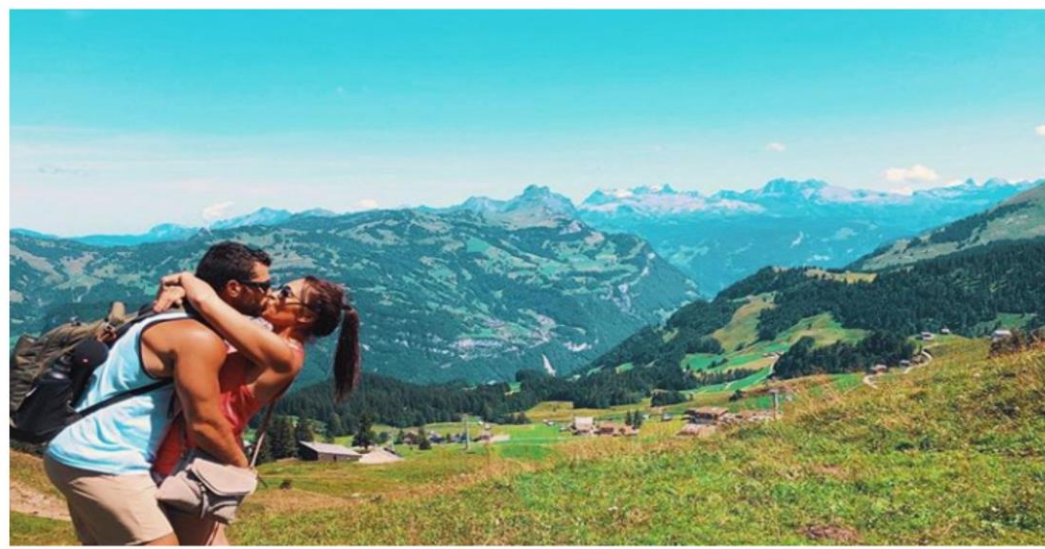
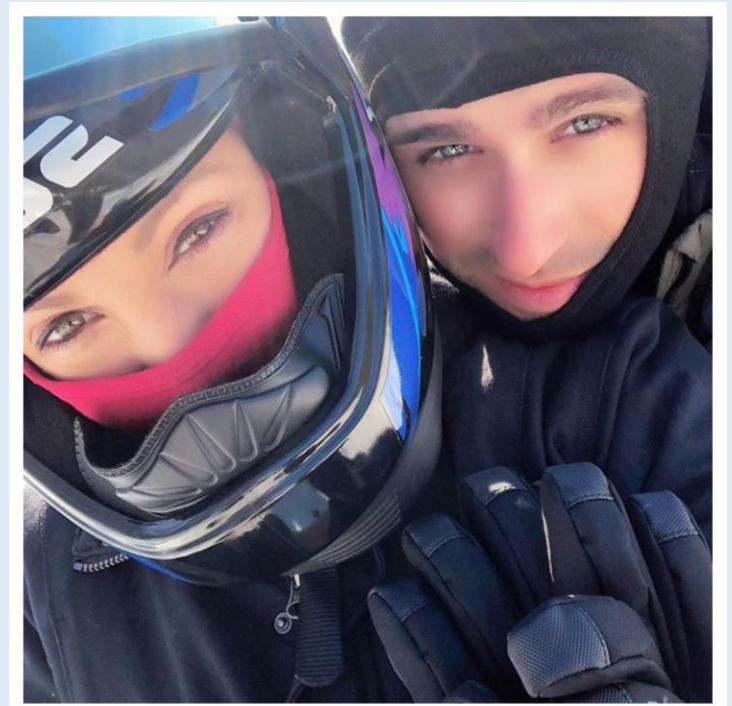


# Kia

Kia has been in country radio for over 10 years!



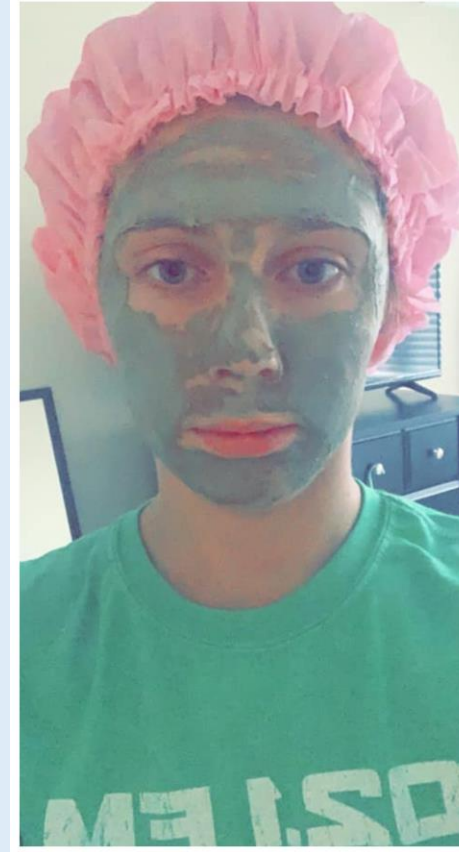


# McKaila

# Chris Carr Wash

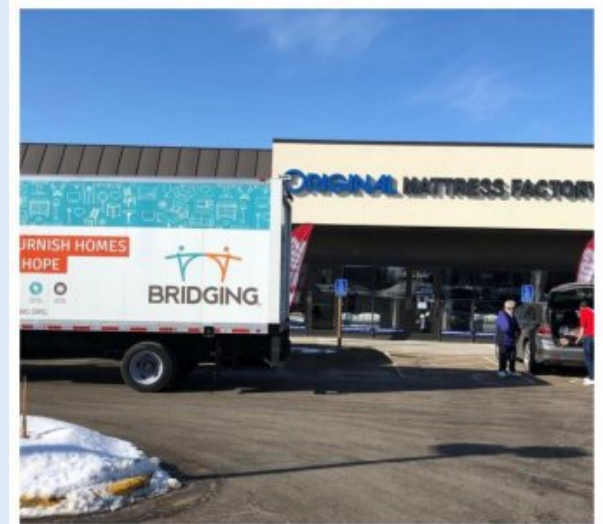

# Meals for the Military

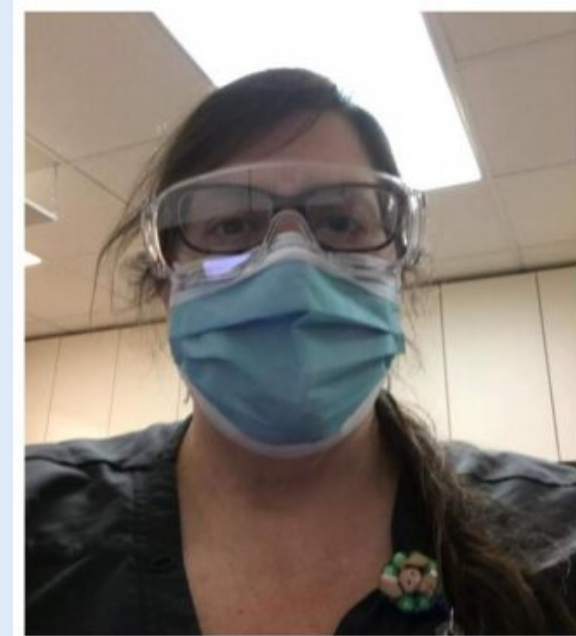

# Delano 4th of July Celebration

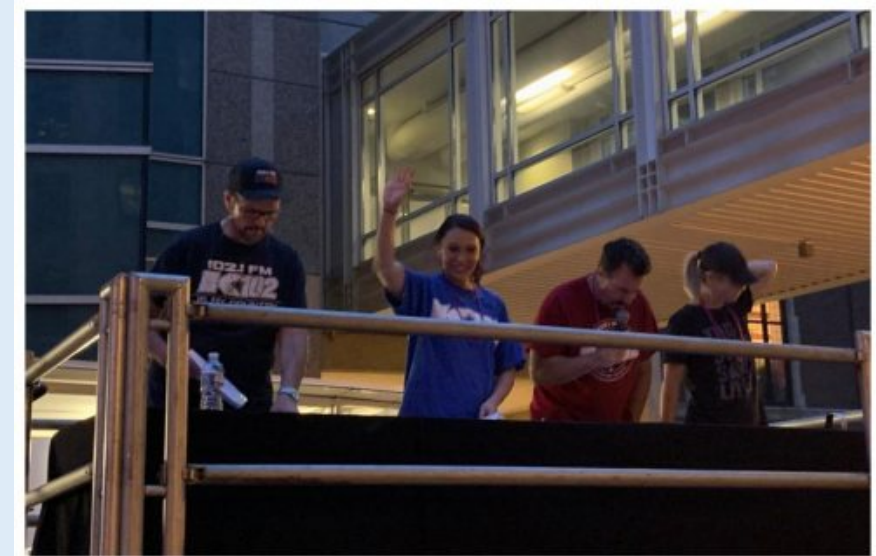

# Fish Fry

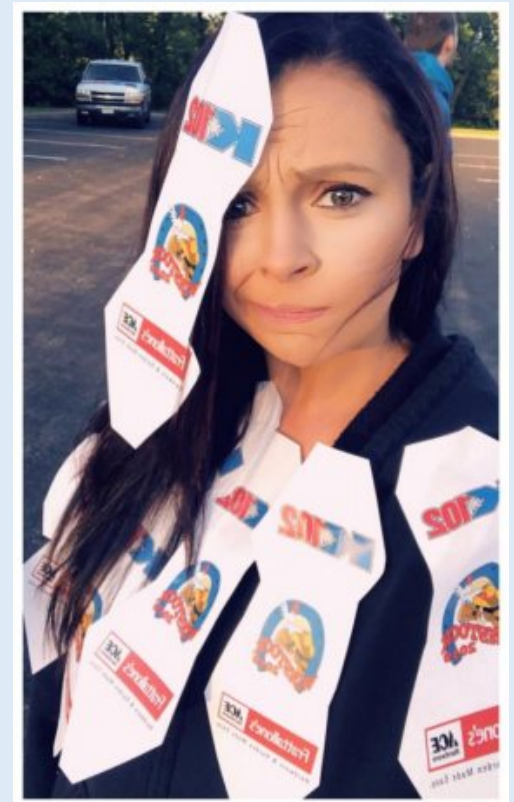

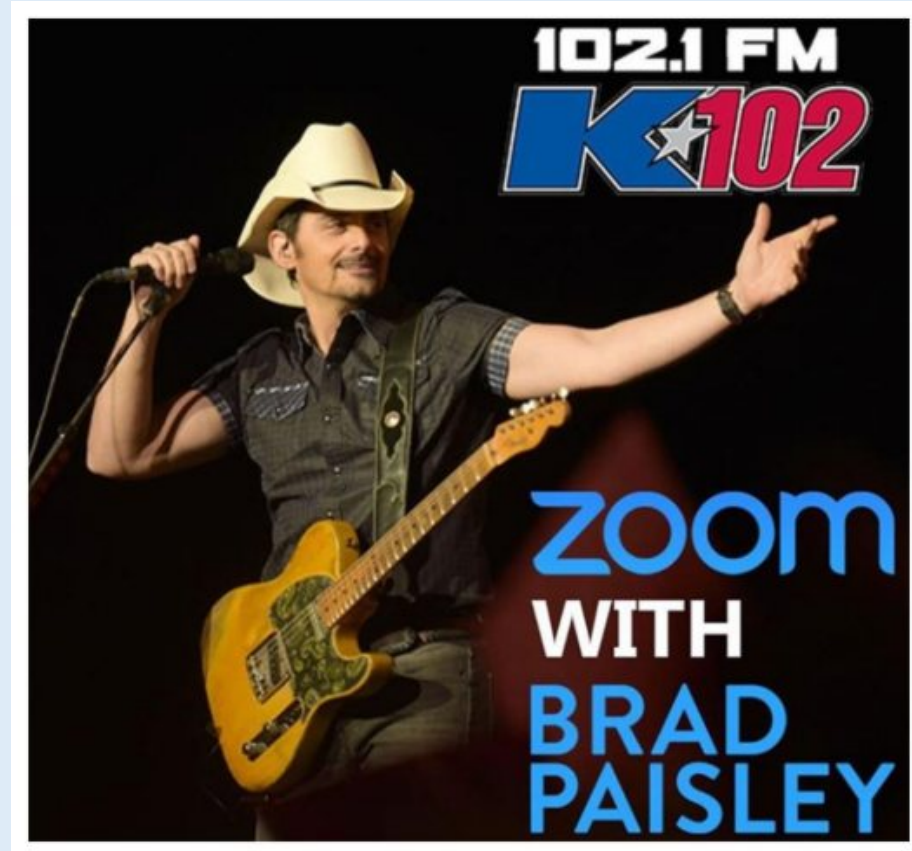
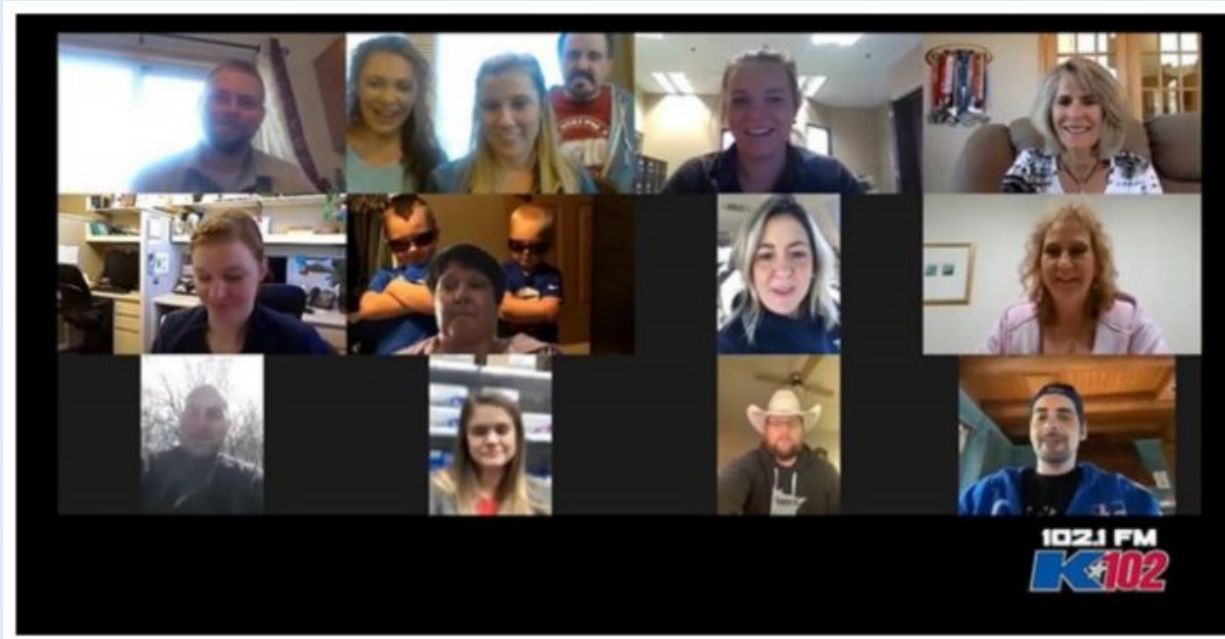

# Zoom Call with Brad Paisley

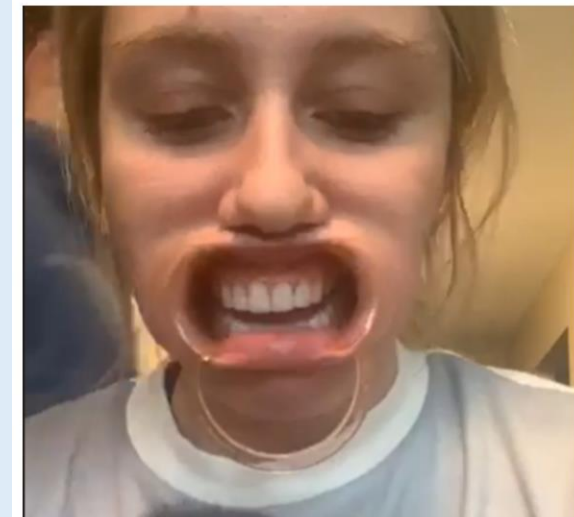
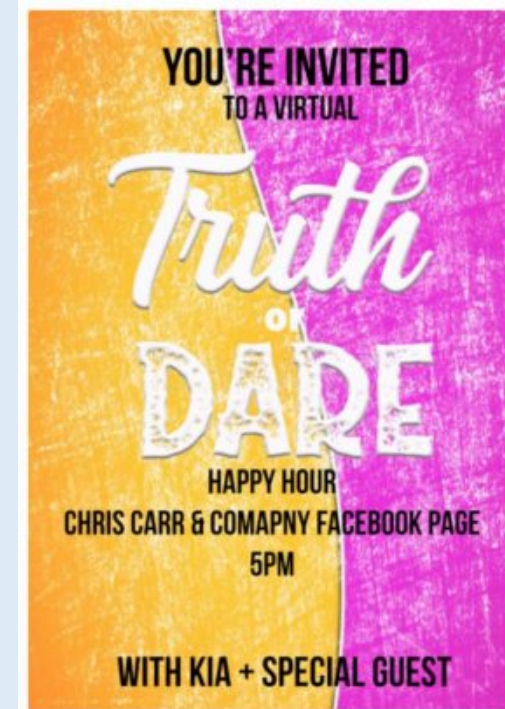
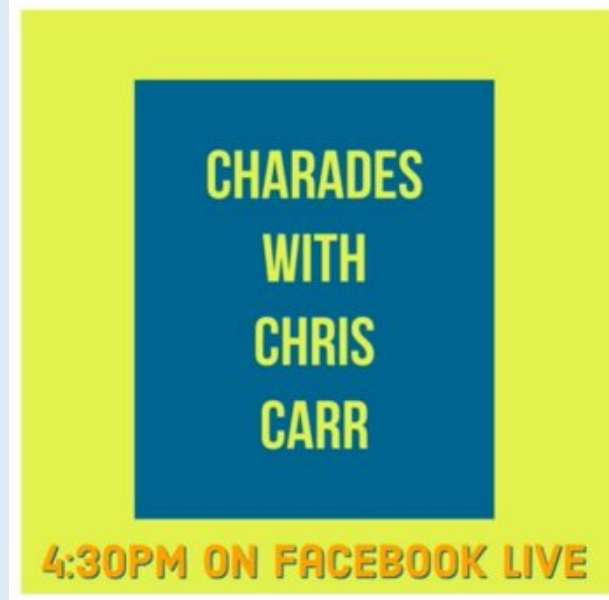
