Tec,

On behalf of United Way of the CSRA's Board of Directors and thousands of individuals that we serve, I wanted to thank you once again for allowing us to be the beneficiary of the 2019 Kicks 99 Guitar Pull which raised \$25,100 for emergency services to families with children in our community. We are so thankful to you, your colleagues, and Kicks 99 listeners for such generosity.

Since this partnership began nearly 20 years ago, over \$466,000 has been raised from the Kicks99 Guitar Pull events which has, in turn, provided immense support to families in our region.

As fundraising has grown increasingly difficult, there are very few agencies able to provide the type of emergency assistance needed by many families, especially those with children. Thanks to the Kicks99, United Way is able to continue these necessary services throughout the community.

Please share with your staff and supporters the impact the Guitar Pull funds had in 2019 right here in our community:

- Provided 120 families with utility bill assistance, enabling them to keep the power, gas or water on in their homes.
- Assisted 28 families with rent or mortgage payments, ensuring they would remain in their homes.
- These families included 320 children who were able to concentrate on their education and all things that children should think about without worrying about their basic needs being met.
- 503 total individuals were positively impacted by these funds.

So many lives are better as a result of your generosity. Here are just a few of the many families touched by your generosity:

- So many of the families in our area are considered the "working poor", usually living pay check to pay check. One unexpected event is enough to cause tremendous hardship. One case is the mom of two whose children became sick with a stomach virus. She normally earns just enough to pay all of her bills, but during this pay period she missed 5 days of work. That meant a loss of 30 hours from that pay check. With this assistance, she was able to pay her bills and stay on track.
- Many of those served are in need of assistance to get through a tough place, but have the ability to "catch up" with this help. One example is this single mom who decided to start cleaning

offices and houses when she was not able to find a job quickly. She has used all of her 401K and exhausted her savings. She has an autistic child of her own and has just received custody of an infant grandchild with special needs. She receives SSI for the infant. The parents of the baby are not in the picture. She is trying to get her cleaning business going and is being somewhat successful. These funds provided \$200 on rent and \$225 for utilities. These payments will bring her back to even and she plans to keep up after this. Additional funds were contributed by partner agencies and the faith-based community. When these dollars are matched by our network of partner agencies, the impact of this generous donation is multiplied.

- There are individuals with disabilities, however, who are not always able to catch up so easily. During 2019, 16 individuals disclosed that they had a disability that kept them from working full time. By providing assistance to them and working with the family, these individuals avoided eviction and utility disconnection. These individuals were provided with additional resources, such as Forces United, to ensure the family remained stably housed. One example of this is a disabled veteran who received utility assistance for one month as he awaited an increase in his VA benefits. His wife is working, but she is pregnant. Her work has been limited due to the pregnancy. This family was also referred to Forces United for ongoing assistance.

We thank all of you at Kicks99 for your continued support of United Way of the CSRA's work. Truly, you are making a difference in our community!

On behalf of United Way of the CSRA's Board of Directors and thousands of individuals that we serve, I wanted to thank you once again for allowing us to be the beneficiary of the 2019 Kicks 99 Guitar Pull which raised \$25,100 for emergency services to families with children in our community. We are so thankful to you, your colleagues, and Kicks 99 listeners for such generosity.

Since this partnership began nearly 20 years ago, over \$466,000 has been raised from the Kicks99 Guitar Pull events which has, in turn, provided immense support to families in our region.

As fundraising has grown increasingly difficult, there are very few agencies able to provide the type of emergency assistance needed by many families, especially those with children. Thanks to the Kicks99, United Way is able to continue these necessary services throughout the community.

Please share with your staff and supporters the impact the Guitar Pull funds had in 2019 right here in our community:

- Provided **120** families with utility bill assistance, enabling them to keep the power, gas or water on in their homes.
- Assisted **28** families with rent or mortgage payments, ensuring they would remain in their homes.
- These families included **320** children who were able to concentrate on their education and all things that children should think about without worrying about their basic needs being met.
- **503** total individuals were positively impacted by these funds.

So many lives are better as a result of your generosity. Here are just a few of the many families touched by your generosity:

- So many of the families in our area are considered the "working poor", usually living pay check to pay check. One unexpected event is enough to cause tremendous hardship. One case is the mom of two whose children became sick with a stomach virus. She normally earns just enough to pay all of her bills, but during this pay period she missed 3 days of work. That meant a loss of 30 hours from that pay check. With this assistance, she was able to pay her bills and stay on track.
- Many of those served are in need of assistance to get through a tough place, but have the ability to "catch up" with this help. One example is this single mom who decided to start cleaning

offices and houses when she was not able to find a job quickly. She has used all of her 401K and exhausted her savings. She has an autistic child of her own and has just received custody of an infant grandchild with special needs. She receives SSI for the infant. The parents of the baby are not in the picture. She is trying to get her cleaning business going and is being somewhat successful. These funds provided \$200 on rent and \$225 for utilities. These payments will bring her back to even and she plans to keep up after this. Additional funds were contributed by partner agencies and the faith-based community.
